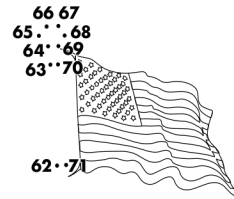

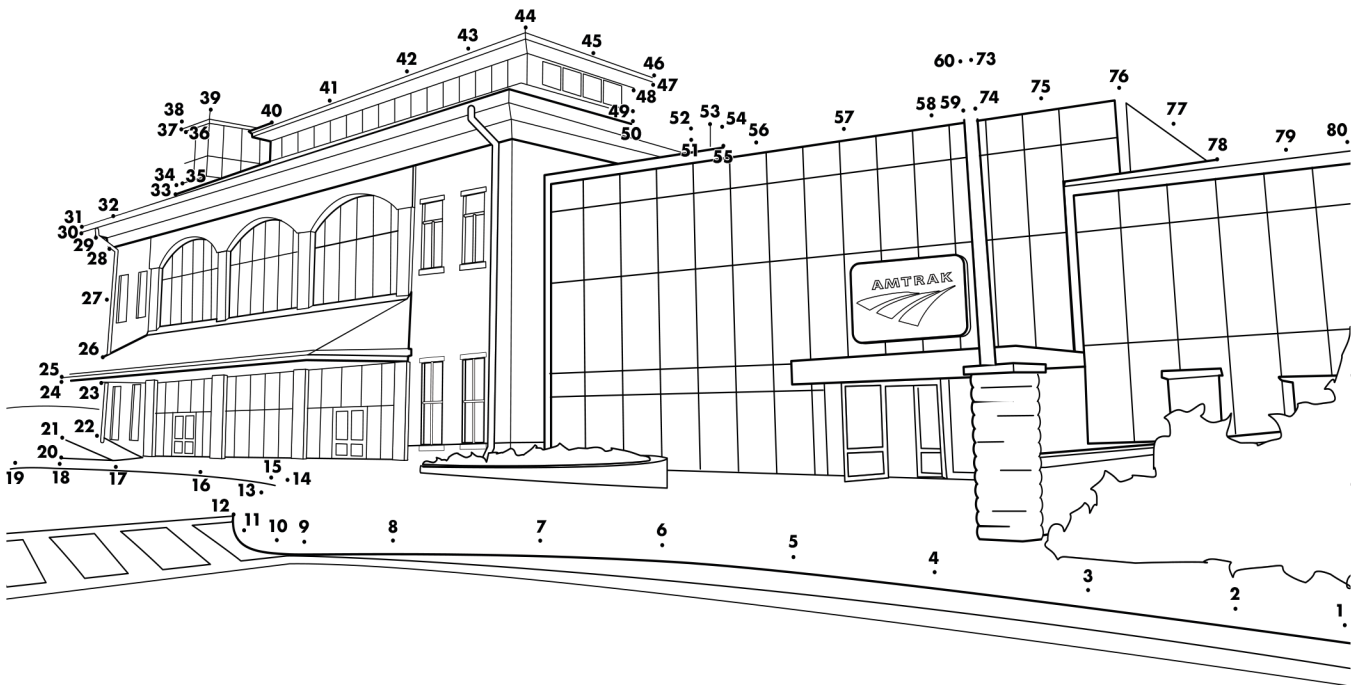

other modes of transportation.

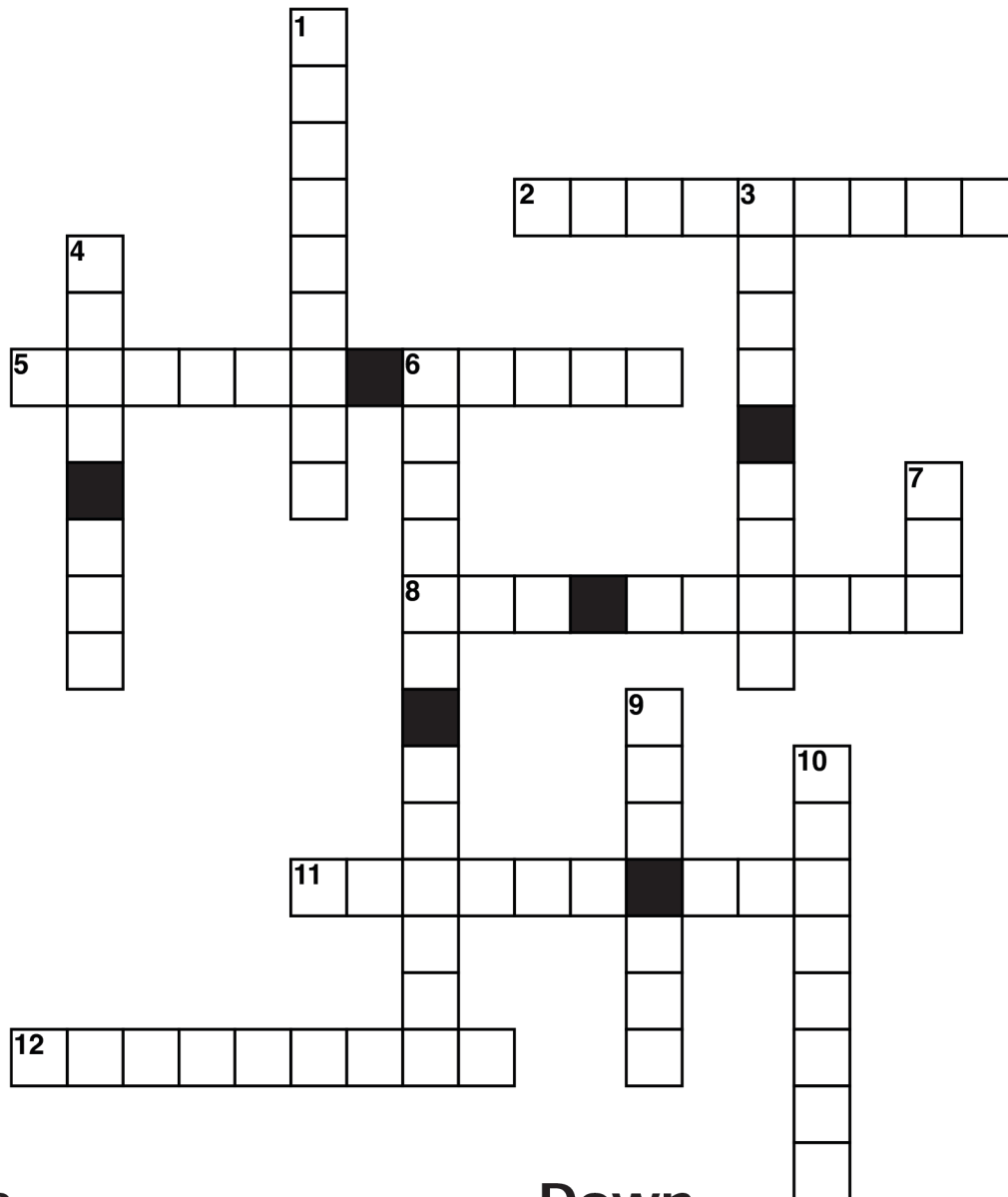
